Festival Cha Cha

Music and Tempo: Cha-Cha 4 /4 at 29 bars per minute

Dance Hold: Kilian (except for steps 17 & 18). Both partners skate the same way Based on contributions from Maria Ball, Derek Drury and Anne McGarry

The Festival Cha-Cha-Cha is a half pattern dance, therefore it is repeated on the other side of the rink, so bringing one back to the original start.

The dance is skated in Kilian hold, starting at the end of the rink, with the exception of steps 17 and 18. These steps are skated side by side whilst doing a three turn independently of each other.

The skaters must reflect the rhythm of the dance with free leg expression, and appropriate syncopated body rhythm, in time to the Cha-Cha music.
